RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON

Be it remembered that at a meeting of the Common Council of the Town of Stayton held on the 27th day of March, 1952, the following action was taken, in the matter of right of way easements.

Town of Stayton

That Whereas the Town of Stayton has acquired , through negotiations, a perpetual right of way and easement over and across and in and to lands owned by T. G. Freres and Frances Freres, husband and wife; A. B. Dombrowsky, single; Lois E. Williams, single, Richard Schotthoeffer and Gertrude Schotthoeffer, husband and wife; C. K. Avey and Barbara Avey, husband and wife; J. H. McMann and Leona McMann, husband and wife, Frank Forrette and Doris Forrette, husband and wife; and Stayton Canning Co. Co-op., and

Whereas said right of way agreement shall be for the purpose of clearing, trenching for, laying, constructing, perpetually maintaining and perpetually repairing a pipeline for a water system and for a sewer system for said Town of Stayton.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON, THAT THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT AND OWNED BY THE ABOVE NAMED PARTIES IS TO BE ACCEPTED AND BECOME A PERPETUAL RIGHT OF WAY AND EASEMENT FOR THE TOWN OF STAYTON AND TO BE USED AS ABOVE SET FORTH. SAID DESCRIPTION ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
