NEW BUSINESS

Election of Parks Board Officers- Ms. Meyer accepted nomination as Secretary, passed 5:0. Mr. Lewis volunteered to be Vice-Chair, seconded by Mr. Vohs, Passed 5:0. Mr. Westlund accepted nomination as Chair, passed unanimously.

Open Discussion or comments about any of the City Parks – The Board discussed the status of Wilderness Park. Mr. Ludwick has no new information about the Agreement between the City and Santiam Water Control District regarding Wilderness Park. The new coatings on the play structure at Quail Run Park are holding up well. Santiam Water Control District was notified about a fallen tree that is across the ditch next to the Library.

Goal Setting for 2020- Mr. Vohs moved and Mr. Brummer seconded to adopt the following goals for 2020, passed unanimously.

- Write guides for the trails that will give history of the area.
- Construct a shelter at Quail Run Park and replace the pea gravel with certified cedar chips.
- Add benches or tables on concrete pads at Pioneer Park near the southern portion behind the playground area.
- Work on connecting the trail system by focusing on one segment at a time.
- Make videos for each park and post on website.
- Have signage/markers along the Stayton Ditch that has historical information.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Brummer noted that there are already easements on record for some neighborhoods that are designated for future City trails. Mr. Nielson suggested having more City sponsored/promoted recreation opportunities.
