- *AJ proposed that there be gravel parking and have asphalt paths to transport kayaks and coolers

- 6. BIG Rock
- 7. Park Land Ends -Beyond the fence post (City Wells)
- 8. Boy Scout Bridge
- 9. Culvert out of Overflow pond -Path around it (Fish pond -for kids only)
