All parties interested in providing public comment or testifying as part of a public hearing shall participate using one of the following methods:

- <u>In-Person Comment</u>: Parties interested in providing in-person verbal public comment shall fill out a request a "Request for Recognition" form available at the meeting. Forms must be filled out and submitted to staff prior to the meeting start time.
- <u>Video or Audio Conference Call</u>: Parties interested in providing verbal comment for the public hearing shall contact City staff at <u>CityGovernment@staytonoregon.gov</u> at least three hours prior to the meeting start time with their request. Staff will collect their contact information and provide them with information on how to access the meeting to provide comment.
- <u>Written Comment</u>: Written comment submitted to <u>CityGovernment@staytonoregon.gov</u> at least three hours prior to the meeting start time will be provided to the public body in advance of the meeting and added to the public body's webpage where agenda packets are posted.
