- <u>Video or Audio Conference Call</u>: Parties interested in providing verbal comment for the public hearing shall contact City staff at CityGovernment@staytonoregon.gov at least three hours prior to the meeting start time with their request. Staff will collect their contact information and provide them with information on how to access the meeting to provide comment.
- <u>Written Comment</u>: Written comment submitted to <u>CityGovernment@staytonoregon.gov</u> at least three hours prior to the meeting start time will be provided to the public body in advance of the meeting and added to the public body's webpage where agenda packets are posted.
