The Stayton Public Library is excited to announce a visit featuring Oregon author Wayne Harrison on Thursday, October 20, 2016 at 7:00 pm in the E. G. Siegmund Meeting Room. There will be a wine and cheese reception accompanying the event.

Wayne Harrison was an auto mechanic for six years before starting college. His short stories have appeared in *Best American Short Stories*, *The Atlantic*, *Narrative Magazine*, *McSweeney's*,



*Ploughshares*, *Crazyhorse*, *Salon.com*, *The Sun* and on NPR's *All Things Considered*. His debut novel, *The Spark and the Drive*, was published by St. Martin's Press in 2014, and his short story collection *Wrench*, which was a finalist for

the Iowa Book Award and runner-up for the Flannery O'Connor Award, won the 2016 New American Prize and will be published in 2017. He teaches writing at Oregon State University.

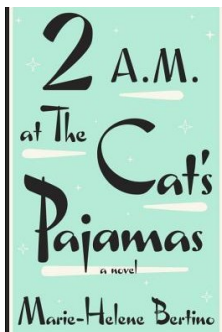

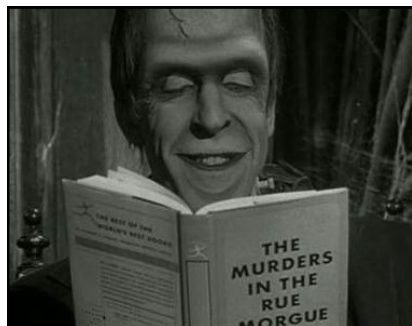

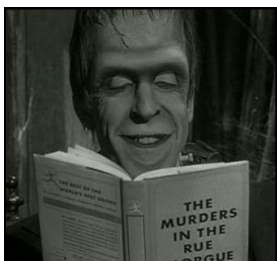
