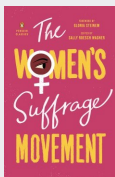

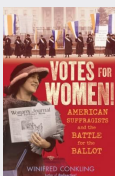

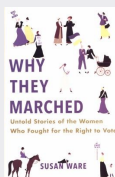

## Kimberly Jensen: *Diverse Women in the Oregon Suffrage Movement*

**Thu, Apr 2, 7:00 pm**

The Stayton Public Library is excited to welcome historian Kimberly Jensen to speak on Women's Suffrage on Thursday, April 2, 2020 at 7:00 pm in the E. G. Siegmund Meeting Room. There will be a reception accompanying the event.

The focus of the evening's presentation will be on diverse women in the Oregon suffrage movement.



Kimberly Jensen is Professor of History and Gender Studies at Western Oregon University. She is the author of *Mobilizing Minerva: American Women in the First World War* and *Oregon's Doctor to the World: Esther Pohl Lovejoy and a Life in Activism*. Her current book project is a study of women, citizenship, and civil liberties in the early twentieth century. She is a board member of the Oregon Women's History Consortium and she and her students have created online resources for the centennial of Oregon's ratification of the Nineteenth Amendment at the Oregon Women's History Consortium website.



The Stayton Public Library is announcing a call for artwork for the 2020 Summer Reading Program. Submitted artwork should be inspired by the Summer Reading Theme, "Imagine Your Story", which highlights fairytales, mythology, and fantasy.
