SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- April 2023

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 74.78 million gallons were treated during April. The highest Daily flow was 5.16 million gallons on the 11th and the lowest flow was 1.52 million gallons on the 29th and the 30th. The average flow was 2.49 million gallons. Total rainfall for April was 7.32 inches. 8.75 yards of bio solids were hauled off site in April.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,939,000 gallons on April 6, 2023.
- **Water System** Replaced 1 meter. Cleaned #2 filter bed.
- **Streets** Swept 29 curb miles and 12 cubic yards of material was collected.
- **Parks** Construction of Dog Park play/exercise equipment. Tree planting at Santiam and Neitling Park.
- **Building Permits**
