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**KEY ACTIVITIES**

**STATUS**

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 36.81 million gallons were treated during July. The highest Daily flow was 1.37 million gallons on the 11th and the lowest flow was 1.05 million gallons on the 23rd. The average flow was 1.19million gallons. Total rainfall for July was 0.02 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in July.
  
- **WTP** Highest production day was 4,209,000 gallons on July 13, 2023.
  
- **Water System** Replaced 14 meters. Replaced 2 meter boxes and repaired 2 water main lines.
  
- **Streets** Swept 247 curb miles and 27 cubic yards of material was collected. 2,718 gallons of Dust Control applied to gravel roads.
  
- **Parks** Nothing to report.
