SUBJECT: April Library report

The Library started April with Food for Fines week. Library fines were reduced by \$1 for each food item contributed. Three hundred seventy-six pounds of food was collected and given to the Stayton Community Food Bank. AARP Tax Aides provided tax assistance at the Library through April 13th. They completed 134 tax returns and helped many more people with tax questions.

Jennifer started a weekly BabyTime program. Comedian and musician, Angel Ocasio helped us celebrate literacy across cultures at our Día de los Niños program.

Oregon author Cathy Lamb visited. She has written twelve novels, including her newest one, *The Man She Married*. Teens solved puzzles to rescue BB-8 at a Star Wars Breakout program, and adults and teens made DIY mini moss gardens.

The Friends of the Library had a record-setting April book sale. They made \$ 5,338.42. Many thanks to Laurie Steel and Pam Pugsley for chairing the sale and to Carol Tabor for doing the publicity. The next sale will be October 3-5.
