ORDINANCE NO. 266

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A DEPUTY RECORDER AND OTHER ASSISTANTS AND PROVIDING FOR THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON TO FIX AND ALLOW THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS; REPEALING ORDINANCES 245 and 261 and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in addition to the powers provided for in Chapter 5 of the City Charter the Mayor shall with the approval of the Council appoint a Deputy Recorder who shall serve under the Recorder and shall perform such duties as may be assigned him, including the duties of Police Judge. Said deputy shall qualify by filing with the Recorder a bond in the sum of \$1,000 approved as to form by the Council, premium for such bond to be paid for by the City as other claims against the Town of Stayton. The Deputy when serving in the capacity of Police Judge shall possess and exercise like authority as the Recorder and his findings, decisions, and rulings shall have the force and effect as though such decisions, rulings and findings were those of the Recorder.

Section 2. The Mayor hereby is given authority to appoint with the approval of the Council such other deputies or assistants as may be needed for the proper transaction of the business of the Town of Stayton.

Section 3. The Council shall prescribe and fix the salary or compensation to be paid to the City Recorder, the Secretary-Treasurer and such deputies and other assistants as may be appointed.

Section 4. That Ordinances No. 245 and 261 be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That whereas the Town of Stayton is in need of a Deputy City Recorder and other assistants and deputies and it is the judgment of the Council that an emergency exists and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of peace, health and safety and that this Ordinance shall become immediately operative upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
