

ORDINANCE NO. 825

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 668, STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 5.24.610, "LIQUOR LICENSES: APPLICATION FEE."

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton has through, Resolution No. 653 established guidelines and procedures for Stayton City Council recommendations for renewal and issuance of liquor licenses;

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 471.155(4), the Oregon Liquor Control Commission has reviewed Stayton Municipal Code Section 5.24.610, and approves City of Stayton Resolution No.653 regarding liquor license review procedures and fees;

WHEREAS, as permitted by ORS 471.166, prudent use of City funds requires that costs for providing services to the liquor license applicants be recovered, in part, from the applicants receiving those services; and

WHEREAS, in view of increased costs to provide those services, the Stayton City Council finds that it is necessary to amend the section of the Stayton Municipal Code relating to cost of processing liquor licenses.

NOW THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Stayton Municipal Code Section 5.24.610 is hereby amended to read:


5.24.610 Cost of Application Process

The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may require of every applicant for a liquor license, the recommendation in writing, of the City Council. In the event such recommendation is so required, the applicant shall pay for cost of processing prior to the City Council's consideration of the license request in accordance with the schedule determined by City Council resolution.
