

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON AUGUST 21, 1975. SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF STAYTON A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A LEVY BY THE CITY OF A TAX IN THE SUM OF \$100,604.00 OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special election be held in the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, on the 21st day of August, 1975, for the purpose of submitting proposed tax levies in excess of the six per cent (6%) constitutional limitation which is now on file in the office of the recorder of the City of Stayton, which has been proposed by the council, and more specifically set forth as follows:

PROPOSITION

Shall the City of Stayton be authorized to levy a tax on the property in the sum of \$100,604.00 outside the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon, Constitution, for the tax year 1975-76, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund?

If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1975-76 will be \$119,314.00 greater than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

Section 2. That the City Recorder of the City of Stayton is hereby authorized to publish notice of said election in the manner provided by law; and further he shall place said proposal on official ballot to be voted on by the legal electors of said election.

Section 3. That the polling places for said election in the City of Stayton shall be as follows:


PRECINCT NUMBER	Polling Place

Section 4. That the polling places for said election shall be open from the hours of 8:00 O'Clock AM to 8:00 O'Clock PM on said day and that the City Recorder is instructed to take to the polling places booths, pens, **pencils**,

ballots & poll books for the purpose of providing for said election.

Section 5. That inasmuch as the City of Stayton will be without funds to maintain its services in the coming year fiscal year unless the special election herein referred to can be held without delay, the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Stayton, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full, force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
