AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 229 PASSED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON ON THE 3RD DAY OF APRIL, 1939, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 3RD DAY OF APRIL, 1939, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3. First Street in the Town of Stayton shall be the base line for commencing to number all streets extending east and west; and Water Street shall be the base line for commencing to number all streets extending north and south.


All numbering east or west of First Street shall be designated "East" or "West" as the case may be. All numbering south of Water Street shall be designated "South", and all numbering north of Water Street shall be designated "North".
