

ORDINANCE NO. 324

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 248, Section 2, RELATING TO DISORDERLY CONDUCT BY DELETING THE LANGUAGE IN SECTION 2, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2, of Ordinance No. 248 is hereby Amended by deleting the language therein contained and substituting therefore, the following language; "Section 2. Ordinance No. 248. DISORDERLY CONDUCT."

Section 2. Any person doing any violent, riotous, disorderly, destructive, damaging, obscene, immoral, indecent, leud, licentious act, or to use any obscene, profane language in any public place, or public street, shall be guilty of the crime of disorderly conduct.


Section 3. Any person who allows their private property, real or personal to be used for any violent, riotous, disorderly, obscene, immoral, indecent, leud, licentious act, shall be guilty of the crime of disorderly conduct.

Section 4. Any person while on private property who uses any obscene, profane language so that it interferes with the quiet enjoyment of other citizens of the community shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

Section 5. That it is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions in the City of Stayton are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety; and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
