

ORDINANCE NO. 334

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 54

WHICH ATTEMPTED TO VACATE ALLEYS AND ROADWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN OF STAYTON, MARION COUNTY, OREGON, now KNOWN AS THE CITY OF STAYTON, MARION COUNTY, OREGON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, MARION COUNTY, OREGON:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, Ordinance NO. 54 enacted on the 6th day of September, 1901, relating to the vacation of certain alleys and streets within the City of Stayton, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the legal requirements relating to posting of Notices, Advertising, and Petition of Property Owners, was not obtained by the City beforehand in conformance with the Oregon Laws relating thereto, thus voiding said Ordinance, and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance NO. 54 as it now stands on the records of the City of Stayton, Oregon has constituted and is constituting difficulty with the determination of property rights and property lines, creating administration problems to the City of Stayton, Oregon,


SECTION 2. That Ordinance No. 54 relating to vacation of certain alleys and streets shall be and hereby is vacated and repealed and held to be void and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is deemed necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health and safety, therefore it is hereby Adjudged and Declared that an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be and become effective im-


mediately upon its passage and adoption by the Common Council of the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon and approval by the Mayor.
