

ORDINANCE NO. 343

An Ordinance declaring withdrawal from the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District of property therein that has been annexed to the City of Stayton, Oregon.

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Stayton, Oregon, having complied with the laws of the State of Oregon pertaining to annexation to the city of property within the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District and having held a public hearing, after giving <sup>lawful</sup> notice thereof, on the question of withdrawal of such property from said district, and no objections having been made at such hearing to such withdrawal, the city does hereby declare, as required by law, that the said property heretofore annexed to said city and described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 40.38 chains North 89° 11' East and 45.3 links South 0° 39' East from the quarter section corner between Sections 10 and 11, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon, said point being in the middle of the County Road leading from Stayton to Mehama, Oregon; thence South 89° 23' East along the middle of the County Road 3.163 chains; thence South 0° 39' East 3.163 chains; thence North 89° 23' West 3.163 chains to a point on the West line of that certain tract of land described in deed recorded on page 564, Book 284, Deed Records of Marion County, Oregon; thence North 0° 39' West 3.163 chains to the place of beginning; being situated in Section 11, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, State of Oregon.

Excluding any and all county roads.

is withdrawn from the said Stayton Rural Fire Protection District.
