

ORDINANCE NUMBER 378

An Ordinance vacating that portion of  
Cherry Street lying south of Ida Street  
in the City of Stayton, Oregon.

WHEREAS, that portion of Cherry Street which deadends  
south of West Ida Street in the City of Stayton, Marion County,  
Oregon, is not and has not been used as a city street, and

WHEREAS, no plans are being made to open and improve  
this as a street, and

WHEREAS, no objections have been presented at the Public  
hearing or otherwise regarding such vacation, now therefore,

THE CITY OF STAYTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of Cherry Street which dead-ends  
south of West Ida Street, in the City of Stayton, Oregon, more  
particularly described as follows, to-wit:


That portion of Cherry Street (Northwest "C" Street)  
in Ottomar Luttich Addition to the City of Stayton,  
Oregon, lying South of the South line of Ida Street  
more particularly described as follows:  
Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 6, Block 9,  
Ottomar Luttich Addition, in Township 9 South, Range 1  
west of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon;  
thence South 47.5 feet; thence West 60.00 feet; thence  
North 47.5 feet to the South line of Ida Street; thence  
East 60.00 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That portion of Cherry Street which dead-ends  
south of Ida Street as described in Section 1 above shall be  
and hereby is vacated.


Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that the  
existing conditions in the City of Stayton are such that this  
ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
public peace, health and safety, and an emergency hereby is  
declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be  
in full force and effect from and after its passage.
