

ORDINANCE NO. 180.

for

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinances No. 177 and No. 178 and declaring an emergency to exist.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 177 and Ordinance No. 178 be, and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 2. That inasmuch as it is necessary that said Ordinances be immediately repealed in order that time and expense be saved the Town of Stayton, and inasmuch as said Ordinances can serve no purpose by longer remaining in force, it is the judgement of this Council that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Stayton and its inhabitants that this Ordinance be at once operative, and that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
