

ORDINANCE NO. 55.

A Bill for an Ordinance to vacate the alley extending through Block No. two (2) in Stayton Addition to the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon. WHEREAS, it appearing to the Council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, from the verified petition of George Neibert, that he is the sole owner of all of block No. two (2) in Stayton's Addition to the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, and it appearing to the Council from the proof now on file that due and legal notice of the pendency of said petition has been given for more than thirty days previous to this 5 day of September, 1901, (at) the regular September setting of the Council, and no opposition having been made to said petition and it further appearing that the interests of the public will not be prejudiced by the granting of said petition; THEREFORE:

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the alley running North and South being sixteen feet wide and extending through Block No. two (2) in Stayton's Addition to the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, as shown and designated upon the recorded plat thereof, now on file and of record in the Recorder's Office of said Marion County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated the whole way through said Block as herein described, provided, that said petitioner shall pay all the costs and expenses of said petition and this proceeding.
