

ORDINANCE NO. 94.

An Ordinance changing the time of the regular meetings of the Council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Commencing with the first Tuesday in January, 1910, the regular meetings of the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, will be held on the first Tuesday in each month, at 7 o'clock in the afternoon of said day.

Provided that the Mayor shall have the power to convene the Council in Special Session at any time by giving the members thereof at least ten hours notice.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
