

ORDINANCE No. 564

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON CODE SECTIONS 6.010 and 7.005

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sections 6.010 and 7.005 are amended to read as follows:

6.010 Adoption of Oregon Criminal Code

1. The Oregon Criminal Code, Prohibitions Relating to Liquor and the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, as codified in the Oregon Revised Statutes 1979, and as amended by 1981 Legislature, are hereby adopted. Violations of these provisions shall be an offense against the City, and the procedures therein provided, insofar as possible, apply to the City, except as hereinafter modified.

7.005 Short Title, Applicability of State Traffic Laws

1. The Motor Vehicle Laws of Oregon, ORS Chapters 481 through 487, as amended by the 1981 Legislature, are hereby adopted. Violation of these provisions shall be an offense against this City, and the procedures therein provided, insofar as possible, apply to the City, except as hereinafter modified.

Section 2. If any section or sections of the above described laws are hereafter declared to be invalid, unconstitutional or unenforceable as regards the City of Stayton or the jurisdiction of the Municipal Court, it shall not affect any other Section of said Code.
