

ORDINANCE No. 587

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION FOR : A STREET SERIAL LEVY AND A STREET LIGHT SERIAL LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. For the purpose of providing funds for street lighting and street improvements within the City of Stayton, and for no other purpose, the Stayton City Council hereby proposes serial levies of \$60,000.00 and \$42,285.00 per year, for three years, outside the Tax Base limitation imposed by Oregon Constitution Article XI, Section 11.
- The proceeds of the authorized levies shall be set aside in a Street Serial Levy Fund and Street Lighting Serial Levy Fund sepearate and disticnt from other funds of the City.
- The total estimated outlay for the purpose of this levy is \$180,000.00 and \$126,855.00
- Section 2. This Ordinance is submitted to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection at the Election to be held between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., June 28, 1983.
- Section 3. For purpose of submitting this measure to the electorate, the following ballots are hereby approved and adopted:
- Caption: Three Year Street Serial Levy
- Question: Shall the City Levy \$180,000.00 for street improvements beginning in Fiscal Year 1983-1984 ?
- Caption: Three Year Street Lighting Levy
- Question: Shall the City Levy \$126,855.00 for Street Lighting beginning in Fiscal Year 1983-1984 ?
- Section 4. The City Administrator is hereby instrurcted to take such action as is necessary to insure the presentation of this measure to the voters.
- Section 5. It is hereby adjuded and declared that existing conditions in the City of Stayton are of such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the Peace, health, safety and general welfare of the City and the inhabitants thereof, and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
