

ORDINANCE NO. 591

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON CODE SECTION 6.010 and 7.005

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6.010 and 7.005 are amended to read as follows:

6.010 Adoption of Oregon Criminal Code

1. The Oregon Criminal Code, Prohibitions Relating to Liquor and the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, as codified in the Oregon Revised Statutes 1982, and as amended by 1983 Legislature, are hereby adopted. Violations of these provisions shall be an offense against the City, and the procedures therein provided, insofar as possible, apply to the City, except as hereinafter modified.

7.005 Short Title, Applicability of State Traffic Laws

1. The Motor Vehicle Laws of Oregon, ORS Chapters 481 through 487, as amended by the 1983 Legislature, are hereby adopted. Violation of these provisions shall be an offense against this City, and the procedures therein provided, insofar as possible, apply to the City, except as hereinafter modified.

Section 2. If any section or sections of the above described laws are hereafter declared to be invalid, unconstitutional or unenforceable as regard the City of Stayton or the jurisdiction of the Municipal Court, it shall not affect any other Section of said Code.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions in the City of Stayton are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the City and the inhabitants thereof, and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor. Effective dates shall be as set by the State Legislature. Those laws already in general effect shall have local effect as of the signing of this Ordinance by the Mayor.
