

**RESOLUTION NO. 940**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE ADOPTED 2015-16 BUDGET**

WHEREAS, after the budget process for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year, Storm Water fund had expenses that exceeded appropriations in some categories;

WHEREAS, in order to lawfully comply with the requirements of Local Budget Law, a transfer of appropriation is necessary; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 294.463 allows for the transfer of appropriations decreasing an existing appropriation in a fund and increasing an existing appropriation in the same fund.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council wishes to comply with Local Budget Law and transfer existing appropriations within the same fund; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that transfers should be made in the Storm Water fund increasing Material and Services in the amount of \$49,711.50 and decreasing Contingency in the Storm Water fund in the amount of \$49,711.50; and,

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.
