**A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE PROPOSED CHEMEKETA COOPERATIVE REGIONAL LIBRARY SERVICE (CCRLS) GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND LEVY TO UPDATE, IMPROVE, AND/OR REPLACE CCRLS SYSTEM COMPONENTS**


- WHEREAS,** CCRLS has been committed to supporting excellent library service for all people of Polk, Yamhill, and Marion counties for over 18 years; and
- WHEREAS,** The cost efficiency of CCRLS to cities and residents alike is well documented; and
- WHEREAS,** Essential components of CCRLS are the shared automated library system, a van to enable efficient sharing of books between member libraries, and a bookmobile to bring library service to rural residents; and
- WHEREAS,** All three of these capital components have been heavily used, are worn out, and have lasted beyond their expected life; and
- WHEREAS,** The Chemeketa College Board is considering authorization of a 5-year general obligation bond levy for \$1.4 million (about 3 cents per thousand) for the June 29, 1993 election to assure the adequacy of these three critical tools through the next six years;

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

be it resolved that the Stayton City Council hereby endorses the proposed CCRLS levy and pledges to inform its constituents of its importance in the community.
