

RESOLUTION NO. 564

A RESOLUTION ANNOUNCING THE CITY OF STAYTON'S INTENT TO AWARD THE BID FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS TO SLAYDEN CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENT UPON COMPLETION OF THE FINANCING PACKAGE AND THE CONCURRENCE OF THE RURAL ECONOMIC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (RECD) AND THE CITY ATTORNEY.

- WHEREAS, The city received seven bids for proposed improvements to the wastewater treatment plant; and
- WHEREAS, The council concurs with staff's findings that the bid Slayden Construction, Stayton, Oregon, submitted most closely conformed to bid document specifications; and
- WHEREAS, The council recognizes that prior to bid award, a financing package sufficient to meet all construction costs and contingencies must be in place; and
- WHEREAS, The council further recognizes that the grant and loan funds extended through the office of Rural Economic Community Development are a primary source of those funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Stayton City Council that it is the intent of the Stayton City Council to award the bid for wastewater treatment plant improvements to Slayden Construction contingent upon completion of the financing package and the concurrence of the Rural Economic Community Development Office and the city attorney.
