

RESOLUTION No. 595

A RESOLUTION REVOKING RESOLUTION No. 593, WHICH REFERRED TO THE ELECTORATE OF THE CITY OF STAYTON A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE STAYTON CITY CHARTER RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION, WITHOUT PRIOR VOTER APPROVAL, OF THE IMPOSITION OF A TAX OR CREATION OF A TAXING AUTHORITY WHICH MAY IMPOSE A TAX ABOVE THE OREGON CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATION.

WHEREAS the Stayton City Council, at its regularly convened meeting on 16 December 1996, adopted Resolution No. 593, proposing an amendment to the Stayton City Charter relating to the prohibition, without prior voter approval, of imposing a tax or creating a taxing authority which may impose a tax above the Oregon Constitutional limitation; and,

WHEREAS at its regularly convened meeting on 6 January 1997, the Stayton City Council, decided, by a vote of 4:1, to revoke said Resolution No. 593;

NOW, THEREFORE,

the Stayton City Council hereby resolves that Resolution No. 593 is hereby revoked.
