A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$294,900.00 FOR CAPITAL OUTLAY (WATER RESERVOIR AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM).

WHEREAS, on 28 August 1990 the City of Stayton sold General Obligation Bonds, Series 1990-B, for the specific purpose of a major upgrade of the City's water system, and funds from the \$300,000.00 bond sale less underwriter's discount of \$5,100.00 provides funding of \$294,900.00 for the upgrade of the water system; and
