

RESOLUTION NO. 478

A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING CERTAIN TAXES, FEES, CHARGES, ASSESSMENTS, AND BONDED INDEBTEDNESS AS BEING SUBJECT TO OR NOT BEING SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF SECTION 11(b), ARTICLE XI, OF THE OREGON CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution is to classify, pursuant to c. 459 Oregon Laws 1991, the City's taxes, fees, charges, assessments, and bonded indebtedness, as being subject to or not being subject to the property tax limitations of Section 11(b), Article XI, of the Oregon Constitution;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Stayton:

SECTION 1: The following taxes, fees, charges, assessments, and bonded indebtedness are classified as not being subject to the property tax limitations of Section 11(b), Article XI, of the Oregon Constitution:
