

RESOLUTION No. 305

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING SHOP BUILDING CONTRACTS FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the City wishes to contract for the construction of a metal shop building; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Stayton City Code Section 2.355 an informal bid process was employed to solicit bids for the building and the floor/pit contracts, by which process competitive quotes were obtained from at least fifteen contractors in the Stayton area. Solicitation of offers from the competing contractors was in writing and a written record was made containing the source and amount of the quotes received.


In light of the type, cost, amount of the contract and the number of qualified persons available to bid, the Council finds that this procedure is reasonable. The Council further finds that by this informal bid process it is unlikely that favoritism is encouraged or competition is diminished. Lastly, awarding the contract pursuant to an exemption from the competitive bidding process will result in substantial cost savings to the City.

On such findings, be it therefore RESOLVED,

That the contracts for the construction of the shop building and maintenance pit be and the same is hereby exempted from the competitive bidding process.


