

RESOLUTION NO. 155

RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION BY LOCAL HOUSING OWNERS IN THE FEDERAL RENT SUPPLEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS: Under provisions of Section 101 of the Housing and Urban Development Act. of 1965, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development is authorized to enter into Contracts to make rent supplement payments to certain qualified housing owners on behalf of qualified families who are elderly, handicapped, displaced, victims of natural disasters, or occupants of sub-standard housing, and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 101 can not be made available for housing owners in certain localities unless governing body of the locality has by resolution given approval for such participation in the Federal Rent Supplement Program, and

WHEREAS, the Council has examined the tentative plans for development of property located at Third and Washington Streets, Stayton, Marion County, Oregon:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Stayton, Marion County, State of Oregon, as follows:

Approval is hereby granted for participation in the Federal Rent Supplement Program by qualified housing owners of the property located on the Northeast corner of Third and Washington Streets, City of Stayton, Marion County, State of Oregon.
