

RESOLUTION # 54

Resolution of the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, Oregon.

Be it remembered, that at a meeting of the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, held on the 5th day of June, 1961, the following action was taken.

RESOLVED: That the Common Council does hereby authorize the Mayor of the Town of Stayton to make and sign an application for a Federal Grant of \$30,231.72 for sewage treatment works under 33.S.C.466, relating to Federal Assistance in the construction of interceptor sewer, raw sewage, pumping station, waste stabilization ponds and sewage collection system; and to represent to the government that an election shall be held in the Town of Stayton, State of Oregon on or about September 15, 1961, to obtain the authority of its citizens to issue general obligation bonds to provide funds for the city's portion of the construction costs for the treatment facilities set forth above.
