Authorizing the Police and Traffic Committee to establish pedestrian lanes and erect speed limit signs on Washington Street in the Stayton Canning Company area.

WHEREAS, it has been found necessary for proper traffic control and the safety of pedestrians to establish two pedestrian lanes and erect two "20 MPH" speed limit signs in the area of the Stayton Canning Company on West Washington Street, and;


WHEREAS, City Ordinance Number 267 authorizes the Police and Traffic Committee, subject to the Common Council's approval by resolution, to establish such pedestrian lanes and erect such signs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council, the governing body, to authorize the Police and Traffic Committee to proceed with the establishment and erection as outlined above, subject to Oregon State and Marion County regulations.
