A word from Mayor Vigil...

We are moving forward with several projects which have long-term benefits for the citizens of Stayton.

Stayton Wastewater Facility Upgrade: Slayden Construction Group is proceeding with a \$10 million upgrade to the Wastewater Treatment Facility to ensure treated wastewater discharged to the North Santiam River meets strict water quality requirements. The project will be completed in June 2012.



Riverfront Park Management Plan: Riverfront Park is a 55+ acre park and open space area east of 1st Avenue along the North Santiam River. In April 2011, the City, Marion County and the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board approved a long-term management plan to preserve the conservation values of the Riverfront Park. The Plan encourages restoration of the forested riparian habitat along the river and the preservation of wetlands while permitting low impact recreational uses. Recreational trails, river overlooks and interpretive signage will be provided throughout the park.

One of the Council's goals is to improve the public infrastructure which serves our citizens. These projects help accomplish this goal by improving our parks and wastewater facilities. They also demonstrate the City's commitment to responsible stewardship of our natural resources.
