SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report – May 2025

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility: WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 31.82 million gallons were treated during May. The

highest Daily flow was 1.08 million gallons on the 3rd and the lowest flow was 0.87 million gallons on the 24th and 25th. The average flow was 0.97 million gallons.

Total rainfall was 1.18 inches.

• WTP: Highest production day was 4,610,000 gallons on May 9, 2025.

• Water System: Replaced 3 meters. Installed 1 new meter with radio and replaced 1 fire hydrant.

Cleaned #1 Filter Bed.

• Streets: Cold Mix Applied – 720 lbs. 3 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads. Replaced or

installed 6 signs.

• Parks: No volunteer group activities or equipment replacement in May.
