## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility: WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 27.20 million gallons were treated during June. The

highest Daily flow was 1.24 million gallons on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and the lowest flow was 0.68 million gallons on 8<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 0.91 million gallons. Total rainfall was

1.39 inches.

• WTP: Highest production day was 4,232,000 gallons on June 25, 2025.

• Water System: Replaced 9 meters and 2 water service lines.

Streets: Cold Mix Applied – 540 lbs. 4 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads. Replaced 3

signs.

• Parks: 1 playground equipment repaired, no volunteer group projects.
