SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- February 2022

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 36.82 million gallons were treated during February. The

highest Daily flow was 1.71 million gallons on the 1st and the lowest flow was 1.04 million gallons on the 27th. The average flow was 1.32 million gallons. Total rainfall for February was 1.67 inches. No bio solids were

hauled off site in February.

• WTP Highest production day was 3,015,000 gallons on February 18, 2022.

Water System Replaced 3 water meters. Installed 2 new meters with radio reader and replaced

1 radio reader. Replaced 4-meter boxes and repaired 1 hydrant.

Streets
Swept 12 curb miles and 6 cubic yards of material was collected. 100 cubic pards

of sweeping material hauled off to Coffin Butte.
