SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- February 2025

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 68.97 million gallons were treated during February. The highest Daily flow was 5.3 MGD on the 25th and the lowest flow was 1.46 MGD on the 8th. The average flow was 2.46 MGD. Total rainfall for February was 6.82 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,454,000 gallons on February 7, 2025.
- **Water System** Replaced 6 meters. Replaced 5 meter boxes. Replaced 0 water service lines.
- **Streets** Swept 65 curb miles with 13 cubic yards of material removed from the streets. 4 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads.
- **Parks** 2 tons of debris collected at parks, 20 hours of park maintenance. 2 hours volunteer assistance with disassembling picnic tables to help with RDS.
- **Building Permits**
