SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- January 2025

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 74.99 million gallons were treated during January. The highest Daily flow was 4.19 million gallons on the 4th and the lowest flow was 1.31 million gallons on the 30th. The average flow was 2.29 million gallons. Total rainfall was 3.85 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,478,000 gallons on January 17, 2025.
- **Water System** Replaced 11 meters. Replaced 1 meter box. Replaced 0 water service lines.
- **Streets** Swept 175 curb miles with 18 cubic yards of material removed from the streets. 9 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads. Replaced 2 30" stop signs, 1 36" stop sign, and 1 regulatory sign was put up.
- **Parks** 0 hours of path/trail maintenance, 1 tons of yard debris collected at parks, 20 hours of park maintenance.
