SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- March 2023

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 65.33 million gallons were treated during March. The highest Daily flow was 3.74 million gallons on the 14th and the lowest flow was 1.55 million gallons on the 23rd. The average flow was 2.01 million gallons. Total rainfall for March was 6.59 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in March.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,314,000 gallons on March 17, 2023.
- **Water System** Replaced 12 meters. Replaced 3 meter boxes and replaced 2 water service lines.
- **Streets** Swept 28 curb miles and 10 cubic yards of material was collected.
- **Parks** None for March 2023.
