SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- March 2025

KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

- WWTP Facility WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 78.28 million gallons were treated during March. The highest Daily flow was 3.54 million gallons on the 22nd and the lowest flow was 1.52 million gallons on the 11th. The average flow was 2.32 million gallons. Total rainfall was 6.72 inches.
- WTP Highest production day was 3,093,000 gallons on March 5, 2025.
- Water System Replaced 4 meters. Replaced 1 meter stop. Replaced 4 meter boxes. Repaired 4 water mains. Repaired 1 water service line. Replaced 2 valve cans. Notified 9 users of high usage/possible leak.
- Streets Swept 120 curb miles with 13 cubic yards of material removed from the streets. 7 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads.
- Parks 1 ton of debris collected at parks, 101 hours of park maintenance. Picnic table refurbishing and securing at Santiam and Pioneer Parks. Established garbage collection by garbage company for the parks.
