## KEY ACTIVITIES STATUS

• WWTP Facility Effluent flows: 58.19 million gallons were treated during May. The highest Daily

flow was 2.48 million gallons on the 7th and the lowest flow was 1.25 million gallons on the 28<sup>th</sup>. The average flow was 1.88 million gallons. Total rainfall for May was 5.95 inches. 46 yards of bio solids were hauled off site in May.

• WTP Highest production day was 3,629,000 gallons on May 27, 2022. Slow Sand Filter

Bed 2 was resanded and the project is 97% complete.

Water System Replaced 14 water meters. Replaced 4-meter boxes and 5 water service lines.

Swept 75 curb miles and 8 cubic yards of material was collected. 10 cubic yards

of sweeping material hauled off to Coffin Butte.
