SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- November 2020

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 45.76 million gallons were treated during November. The highest Daily flow was 2.21 million gallons on November 19th and the lowest flow was 0.93 million gallons on the 1st. The average flow was 1.53 million gallons. Total rainfall for November was 6.53 inches. 22.25 dry tons of bio solids were produced. 0 yards of bio solids were used for lawn fertilizer at the WWTP and 0 yards of Santiam Green was picked up by local citizens in November.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 2,818,000 gallons on November 3rd.
- **Water System** Replaced 15 water meters and 4 radio readers. Water service replacements at 1065 & 1055 Ridgefield Ct. Flushed two hydrants on dead end lines.
- **Streets** Swept 490 curb miles and 130 cubic yards of material was collected. Collected 60 cubic yards of material for fall cleanup. 360 lbs of food and \$45.00 were donated to the food bank.
- **Parks** None for November 2020.
