STATUS

WWTP Facility

Effluent flows: 64.09 million gallons were treated during November. The highest Daily flow was 3.48 million gallons on the 22nd and the lowest flow was 1.13 million gallons on the 9th. The average flow was 2.05 million gallons. Total rainfall was 7.77 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in.

• WTP Highest production day was 3,131,000 gallons on November 20, 2024.

• Water System Replaced 13 meters. Replaced 3 meter boxes. Replaced 1 water service lines.

• Streets Swept 378 curb miles with 150 cubic yards of material removed from the

streets. 10 yards of gravel applied to gravel roads. 3 36" stop signs and 2 $\,$

regulatory signs were put up.
