

Low Interest Loans Available for Home Improvements

Is your home in need of repair? New furnace, insulation, or safety improvements? The City of Stayton Housing Rehabilitation Program has renewed funding available for home improvements for income-qualified homeowners. Properties must be owner-occupied. The owners must meet the guidelines as low- or moderate-income



households and have enough equity in their homes to meet the loan guidelines. The income eligibility depends on household size. As an example, for a household of four, the total household income must be less than \$56,550.

The loans may be used to repair or replace roofing, plumbing and electrical problems, carpet, linoleum, painting, dry-rot, and foundation repairs. The maximum loan amount is \$25,000. No monthly payments are required — the loan is repaid from the

proceeds of the sale of the home. An interest rate of 4% is charged for the first five-years and following that, no additional interest accrues.

The funds for this Program come from a Community Development Block Grant from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development.
