Talk About Texture Putting words to the sensations your child feels while exploring different textures helps build vocabulary.



Look for texture in the world around you

Gather a variety of items with different textures (**soft** blankets, **scratchy** brushes, **smooth** glass, **rough** rocks, etc...) or take a walk and notice textures in things you encounter.

Talk About It

As your child explores each texture, talk about what it feels like for their fingers, sharing some of the words we use to describe each one.

Extend the Learning

Try to find texture opposites: soft/hard, smooth/bumpy, etc... Talk about their differences.
