DIY TETRIS MAGNETS

Supplies:

- Square wooden beads
- Glue Tacky glue is included; you can also use E6000, a hot glue gun, or wood glue
- Magnets

Instructions:

- 1. Start by planning out your design. Lay it out without gluing. (Fig. 1)
- 2. Glue together the beads one by one. Try to allow flat sides (without holes) to show as much as possible, but don't worry if some sides with holes show too. It'll look great anyway! (Fig. 2)
- 3. Once it's completely dry, glue a magnet to the back. The magnets are strong! Make sure to keep them a couple inches apart while the glue dries. Allow it to dry again before using them. (Fig. 3)
