
Materials List

Modifications & Extensions

For a younger crowd...

Collage is an easy way for children to explore their taste in art while using the muscles in their hands to prepare for writing later on. Add some fine motor practice by using scissors to cut pieces smaller, or make different shapes before gluing them to the box.

Looking for a glue-free option?

Try making collages on contact paper! Your masterpiece can be made and re-made as many times as you'd like!

For more advanced learners...

Add different embellishments to your box to reflect your own style.

Different textures and patterns create different effects. Explore what works best for you!









