Now that Summer Reading has wrapped up, we want to thank everyone who participated in making it a great success! We had 430 total participants of all ages reading and exploring with us this summer. Kids read over 54,000 minutes and teens and adults read over 1,100 books! That's so much reading!

In addition to the amazing amount of reading our community did, we gave out over 1,700 take-home activity kits all that help foster a love of learning.

It was very important to us to get books in the hands of people this summer. Have you signed up for Dolly Parton's Imagination Library yet?


The Dolly Parton Imagination Library is a book gifting program that mails a free book each month to registered children, from birth to age 5.

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT

The Federal Communications Commission has launched a temporary program to help families and households struggling to afford Internet service during the COVID-19 pandemic. The Emergency Broadband Benefit provides a discount of up to \$50 per month toward broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers.

Eligible households can enroll through a participating broadband provider or directly with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) using an online or mail in application.






